Resserops (Perrector) falloti (Hupé, 1953) (TH229)

Perrector → Redlichiida → Redlichiina → Redlichioidea → Saukiandidae → Resseropinae

Provenance: Morocco; Tazemmourte

Formation: Ihandar Fm **Age**: Lower Cambrian

Details: A somewhat damaged and therefore incomplete specimen: the genal spines are usually about 2/3 of the body length, and additionally there's only a ghost image of the enlarged spines on the 11th thorax segment (right side of the trilo). From Wikipedia: the species lived during the middle of the Atdabadian or the early part of the Botomian Stage (lasted ca 524 to 518.5 MY ago = 2nd half of the Lower Cambrian). It has been found in southern Morocco, in the *Daguinaspis* and *Resserops* zones near Tazemmourt, Amouslek, amd Ouijiane. It was originally described as *Resserops falloti*. The Treatise considers *Resserops* and *Richterops* subgenera of *Perrector*, which name was proposed by Hupe in the same publication, but appears above it, and would have preference. Later publications however, use *Resserops* & *Richterops* as separate genera.
