Details : Three partials : a thoracocranium (missing the librigena, you know), a second one (but only partial), and a (damaged) pygidium. Original tag in the baglet said ***Acantholomina minuta***, but that was obviously wrong. A friend vendor was offered a box of Czech trilobites (mostly bits), and asked me to make an evaluation of the content (some tags had been displaced). In the end, I was offered the box at the little money I had left that day. [According to biolib.cz, the species appears in the Sheinwoodian-Homerian (Silurian) aged Motol Fm]
