Age: Lower Devonian, Upper Emsian (?-Lower Eifelian)

Details: Complete specimen, sold to me as coming from Ordovician layers (most probably because of the state of preservation). An on-site visit however brought serious doubt, or rather certainty: at the Timrzit site (situated a short distance in SW direction from the village of that name) we find two distinct layers. One is called the *Walliserops* couche by the local diggers, the orther one, only 30m NE from those layers, are named the *Leonaspis* couche (containing also pygidia of an unidentified phacopid), which is somewhat pink in aspect. Most probably, the *Leonaspis* couche is a locally eroded part of the Tazoulait Formation. Complete specimens of *Leonaspis* are relatively rare, but not uncommon...disarticulated sklerites are rather abundant (and make a contrast from the matrix by their darker pink-reddish coulour). Oh yeah, "Timrzit" is to be read as Timerzit ©.
