Details: This pygidium (or rather, its internal mould) was lodged on the backside of a stone being sold for containing a small-sized ("TH176") **Colpocoryphe thorali**. The befriended vendor (with whom I had gone fossil hunting on the very spot this was found) focused my attention to it, knowing of my interest in larger disarticulated trilobite parts. To tell you the truth, I completely forgot about the piece, and now have no idea at all of when I purchased it. There exist 2 subspecies: **M.** (**E.**) **filacovi filacovi** (Munier-Chalmas & Bergeron, 1888) and **M.** (**E.**) **filacovi bergeroni** (Thoral, 1935). At least the first subspecies (cf.) is also present in the Upper Fezouata Fm of the "Zagora" area in Morocco.
