

***Megistaspis (Ekeraspis) filacovi*** (Munier-Chalmas & Bergeron, 1888) (TH205b)

***Megistaspis*** → Asaphida → Asaphina → Asaphoidea → Asaphidae

**Provenance** : France; Montagnes Noires, Vallee du Landeyran

**Formation** : Landeyran Fm

**Age** : Lower Ordovician

**Details** : This pygidium (or rather, its internal mould) was lodged on the backside of a stone being sold for containing a small-sized (“TH176”) *Colpocoryphe thorali*. The befriended vendor (with whom I had gone fossil hunting on the very spot this was found) focused my attention to it, knowing of my interest in larger disarticulated trilobite parts. To tell you the truth, I completely forgot about the piece, and now have no idea at all of when I purchased it. There exist 2 subspecies : *M. (E.) filacovi filacovi* (Munier-Chalmas & Bergeron, 1888) and *M. (E.) filacovi bergeroni* (Thorl, 1935). At least the first subspecies (cf.) is also present in the Upper Fezouata Fm of the “Zagora” area in Morocco.
