Details : Complete specimen, slightly curved (?hunter position?). As can be seen in the detail image of the pygidium, its left field did not prep out that perfect (exoskeleton effaced), but then Scutelluids are generally hard to prep with their exoskeleton being rather thin. Last detail photos (page below) are lateral, showing the animal in a presumed predatory stance (partly dug into the sea floor's sediments, usually with just the eyes coming up, and ready to strike at any nice-looking little bite that happens to pass by).
