

***Skreiaspis sp.*** (TH367)

***Skreiaspis*** → Redlichiida → Redlichiina → Ellipsocephaloidea → Agraulidae

**Details** : Thorax segments...or so I thought. When I checked for pictures of the species on the internet (notably of ***S. spinosus*** from the Drumian Stage Cambrian Buchava Fm at Skryje Buchava), I became aware that the specimen in question is actually a mere external imprint of a partial cephalothorax, which you can see in the center-left part of the stone in the first image. A friend vendor was offered a box of Czech trilobites (mostly bits), and asked me to make an evaluation of the content (some tags had been displaced). In the end, I was offered the box at the little money I had left that day. Just to be complete, I'm also adding images of those (bigger) partial thorax segments, and of an additional oddity. Help with identification of it would be appreciated.
