Details : Complete specimen. Starting up this website has had me looking deeper into the validity of certain genus names, and one thing I found out (from the info I've been able to gather) is that **Eoharpes** most probably does not exist in the Devonian (it's rather exclusive to the Ordovician). More likely, the specimen at hand belongs to **Lioharpes**...which IS (officially) reported from Atchaana (and exclusive to the Devonian). In fact, I already have a specimen (TH244), bought as "Neoharpes" (which doesn't exist!) a month and a half earlier from the same vendor...whom would sell me a "Lioharpes" (obviously an **Eoharpes**) of the Ordovician only a couple of months later! Rather than rant about vending strategies... Another numbering adjustment to make, darned!
