

***Xystridura sp. cf. templetonensis*** (Chapman, 1929) (TH391b-i)

*Xystridura* → Redlichiida → Redlichiina → Paradoxidoidea → Xystriduridae

**Provenance** : Australia; Queensland, North-West of Mount Isa

**Formation** : Beetle Creek Fm

**Age** : Middle Cambrian

**Details** : Several partials on one piece, and on both sides of the stone. On what we'll call the "frontside", there's a near-complete (missing librigenae), the partial cranidium of a far bigger specimen, another "near-complete" (missing librigenae and most of the left side of the beastie and apparently also the pygidium...in essence, not such a very complete trilobite after all, hahahhah)...(read on below for "backside of piece")

On the backside of the piece (below, first a general overlook) there's another near-complete (again missing the free cheeks), the partial (imprint) of a thoracocranidium, a (partial) pygidium, plus two smaller cranidia (one as external imprint). [note : there's other bits on both sides of the stone, but they're not really worth separate mention]
