The "*terminatus*" part in the species' name refers to the ending of the lineage of *Olenellus*; the *Paedeumias* part (erected by Walcott in 1910, whom put his new genus into the Mesonacidae, a view followed by Resser, 1928) is a still often used synonym (it was first recognized as belonging into Olenellidae by Riccio in 1952, but it wouldn't be before 1979 until Palmer & Halley would state evidence of *Peudaemias* being a subjective synonym of *Olenellus*).
