If my research work is correct, Mancetter is a suburb village of Atherstone in North Warwickshire and approximately 20 miles (as the bird flies) ENE from the center of Birmingham...which places it in the "Midlands"...renowned for the "Dudley" trilobite *Calymene blumenbachi*. However, Dudley is situated on the "other side" of Birmingham (about 10 miles in a WWNW-ern direction...in other words : western direction with a slight northern inclination)...or, how surprisingly different in age strata can be with only a 'slight' difference of distance, eh?
