

***Homotelus bromidensis*** Esker, 1964 (TH568 + 568a)

*Homotelus* → Asaphida → Asaphina → Asaphoidea → Isotelidae

**Provenance** : USA; Oklahoma

**Formation** : ? Fm

**Age** : Ordovician

**Details** : 2 specimens, one only partial (a cephalothorax), the other complete albeit disarticulated (re-inforcing the probability that we're dealing with moults here). From a box set including species already in collection (but also some new ones). Detail images first of the "complete" specimen. Additional info (not included with the original tag) : species is from the Bromide Fm (from which it got its name) of Oklahoma's Carter County, and is Sandbian (Upper Ordovician) of age. It is usually found in massed quantities. Speculations are that either it moulted in great numbers, or that the critters were surprised during mating seasons; at any rate, several layers of finds were done, and usually complete specimens are inter-mingled with disarticulated ones
