It is today's consensus that the difference between *Kettneraspis* and *Leonaspis* is determined in the amount of (smaller) spines found between the two bigger ones, with the first having only 2, the latter having 4 smaller spines (extra memory trick: alphabetically *Kettneraspis* comes first, and has the lowest amount of smaller spines).

This therefore (see also detail image below) is definitely a *Kettneraspis*.
